Matson Breaks Shot Put Mark

COLLEGE STATION, Tex. (AP) — Randy Matson, the youthful Texas A&M giant, heaved the shot 67 feet, 11¼ inches and the discus 190 feet, 7 inches Friday night — and that, according to veteran observers, is bound to be the greatest double in track history.

The shot throw bettered Dallas Long's world record of 67 feet, 10 inches. The discus toss came within two feet, nine inches of the national college record.

Track Meets Produce Three Top Performers

Johnny Stewart and Hugh Hampton of West Forsyth and Stuart Peters of Reynolds would make quite a track team, just the three of them.

Stewart and Hampton each won three firsts, though North Forsyth beat West Forsyth, 69-49, in a Forsyth 3-A Conference meet yesterday.

Peters won two firsts and two fourths as Reynolds won its third straight Central 4-A meet. The Demons scored 72 points, Salisbury Boyden had 45 and High Point 31.

Stewart won the high hurdles in :15.6, the 440 in :53.6, and the broad jump with 18 feet, 8 inches.

Hampton won the 100 - yard dash in :11., the 220 in :24.2 and the high jump with 5 feet, 8 inches.

Peters won the high hurdles in :15.8, and the low hurdles in :20.0. He hasn't lost in either of these events.

Barry Quinn of West Forsyth won the 880 in 2:10.9.

North picked up its points with its depth and balance. Harvey Bauguess won the low hurdles and was second in the high hurdles. The Vikings swept the shot and won both relays.

Reynolds' Johnny Johnson won the discus with a toss of 134 feet, 8 inches, and Roland Barnhardt won the broad jump with 20 feet, 4½ inches.

E. Forsyth Wins Track Meet, 78-50

HAMPTON, Tenn. — Led by Raymond Warden's 15½ points, East Forsyth High School track team defeated Hampton High School, 78-50, in a dual meet here yesterday morning.

Two East Forsyth school records were broken. Bob Randall set a discus record with a heave of 131 feet and 4 inches, while the 440-yard relay team of Doug Linville, Jack Albert, Calvin Sell, and Warden broke that event's record with a time of 46.6 seconds.

East Forsyth Coach Dan Crow, who formerly coached the Hampton team, arranged the meet. East Forsyth now has a 3-1 record, and will participate in the Duke-Durham Relays next week.

Raymond Warden and Bill Alexander combined for 27½ points and led East Forsyth to a 93½-24½ track victory over Greensboro Smith yesterday.

Warden, the meet's top individual with 14½ points, won first place in the 100-yard dash and the broad jump, finished second in the high jump, and was a member of the Eagles' triumphant 880-yard relay team.

Alexander won the high and low hurdles events, and finished second in the 220-yard dash.

Greensboro Smith won only two blue ribbons—in the high jump and the shotput.

The meet was held at the North Forsyth track since East Forsyth's track is not in shape.

Doug Linville of the Eagles lost only once in the 100 and is unbeaten in the 220. He has done the 100 in :10.5 and the 220 in :23.8.
