Myers Park edged Hammond by six points, 63-57. Washington and Lee of Arlington, Va., finished third at 41, followed by East Mecklenburg's 39.

More than 600 prep tracksters from 36 schools in North Carolina and Virginia participated.

Led by Raymond Warden's fourth-place finish in the high jump, East Forsyth scored six points. Warden jumped 5 feet, 8¾ inches. East Forsyth's 440-yard relay team finished fifth with a time of 46.6 seconds, and the sprint medley team fifth with a 3-minute, 54-second time.
