## Hestdal Sparks Mustangs To Girls' Sectional Title

SPENCER - Myers Park, led by distance runner Lene Hestdal's three first-place finishes, won the North Rowan girls' sectional track meet Friday.

Hestdal took the 1,600-meter (5:25), 800- (2:20.1) and the 3,200-(11:35) runs.

"I didn't expect (us) to place that well," said Myers Park coach Wallace Davis. "I really didn't think we would win it."

The Mustangs won with  $62\frac{1}{2}$  points. It was  $1\frac{1}{2}$  points more than finisher West Charlotte, the premeet favorite.

"One and a half points," exclaimed West Charlotte coach Ann Davis as she congratulated the Myers Park coach. "You'd better believe it (hurts to lose by

so narrow a margin.)"

Along with Myers Park and West Charlotte, North Rowan (56), Gastonia Ashbrook (34), South Mecklenburg (26) finished among the meet's top five teams. Olympic and Davie County tied for sixth with 24.

The top four qualifiers in each of the 15 events advance to Thursday's regional meet at Myers Park. Top placers in that meet advance to the state meet.

Among Piedmont-area schools with particularily impressive showings was North Rowan and Ashbrook.

North Rowan won both the 800- and 1,600-meter relays.

"It doesn't take many people to score well in a meet like this," said North Rowan coach Leland

Peacock. "We had a few strong athletes."

Ashbrook got a first from Patricia Whitworth in the 200. Her 25.2 clocking edged Hickory's Vanessa Hammond (25.8) and North Rowan's Cassandra Alexander (25.9).

But, clearly the meet's star was Myers Park's Hestdal, an exchange student from Norway.

"I run some distance races," she said. "But the team can't win with just distance. We have to have some throwers, sprinters and
