

Henderson Vance Captures North Carolina Track Title

RALEIGH (AP) — Greg Richardson took victories in the 800- and 1600-meter runs to pace Henderson Vance to an easy victory yesterday in the North Carolina High School Athletic Association track and field meet at North Carolina State's Paul Derr Track.

Also, three meet records fell in the competition, including a one-year old high jump mark.

Richardson ran the 800 meters in 1:52.10, nearly 1 second ahead of Tyrone Forbers of Greenville Rose. Richardson took the 1600 in 4:16.58, a full second in front of Chucky Kugler of White Oak.

Broughton, brother of former North Carolina State distance champions Julie and Mary Shea, shaved 7 seconds off the 3,200-meter run in posting a time of 9:19.7. The next three runners also surpassed the time of 9:26.60 set by Robert Baker of North Iredell in 1980.

Lenwood Harris cleared 6-10½ in the high jump, beating by ¼-inch a record set by Charles Mack of North Forsyth and Marvin Jenkins, also of West Craven, last year.

Westover's 1,600-meter relay team of Derrick Carr, Marcus Black, Marshall Pitts and Craig Jackson finished in 3:16.8, less than five-tenths of a second better than the 3:17.28 registered by Ahoskie in 1980.
