



HISTORY OF THE QUEEN CITY RELAYS

What is now known as the "Queen City Relays" were first run in the 1954-55 school year at the old Central High School track, now Garinger High School.

The next year, due to illness in his family, coach Summers asked Myers Park first year coach Stuart Allen to take this meet to his school where it found a permanent home.

This will mark the twenty-eighth year that this, the oldest relay meet in North Carolina, has been held at Myers Park.

Coach Allen was meet director for the next sixteen years, before he left in 1971 to coach at Handley High School in Winchester, Va. His teams won each of the sixteen years. In 1972 Richard Prince took over as track coach and meet director.

In the twenty-four years of the Queen City Relays, Myers Park has won 19 times, Independence 3 times, and Pinecrest 2 times.

Some changes have been made in the events that were run back in the early years. Rule changes were made as to the number of events a boy competes in and more emphasis was given to make this an all-relay type of meet. Dropped were the mile run, high hurdles, and 100 yard dash, which were replaced by the shuttle hurdle relay, distance medley and sprint medley relays.

Women events were added to the meet in 1974 with two events. Last year, women competed in twelve: 5 field and 7 running. The Mustang women won all the relay titles.

In 1980, the format was changed to add participants from South Carolina, Georgia, Tennessee, and Virginia. Due to the new format the team score was dropped and open events in the 100 meter dash, 3200 meter run and 300 meter intermediate hurdles were added. Also in 1980 several people were honored for their contribution to the relays and Mecklenburg County track. The honorees have events named after them. They are Stuart Allen award for the outstanding male participant, Ralph Sandiford for the outstanding female participant, the Thermon Gibbons 3200 meter run for men and Guy Soule 100 meter dash for men.

There have been many outstanding young men and women who have participated in the Queen City relays and have gone on to gain wide acclaim in college and amateur track circles.

Among the Mustangs is Jeff Howser who, for many years held both the high and low hurdle records for North Carolina high schools. He had an outstanding career at Duke University and in major amateur track meets including the U. S. Olympic Trials.

Other outstanding participants are: Roy Bradley, sprints and jumps; Mike Richey, shot put; Flake Campbell, discus; Lewis Jewell, dashes; Jeff West, distance runs; Paul Vincent, hurdles-dashes; Bill Houston, dashes; Lee Stoffell, discus; Nick Karres, discus-shot; Randy Layman, sprints; Chandler Muse, nationally ranked high jumper; Don and John Brown, 1973 indoor All Americans in middle distance; Becky Brown, 2-time state champion and Record Holder, discus; Ken Dowdle, All American distance runner, and Lene Hestdal, All American distance runner.

Other outstanding participants have been Jeff Moody of Pinecrest, a nationally ranked distance runner, Tony Bateman of Garinger, a 1979 All American collegiate distance Runner, Brad Cox and John Ward of Independence, Broderick and James Bennett of East Mecklenburg, David Hankins Miler of East Mecklenburg, Tony Boular of West Mecklenburg, hurdler, Jim Cooper of South Mecklenburg, distances, Stella Johnson of West Charlotte, hurdler, Eric and Ray Perry, All American hurdlers from Menchville, Albert Toon, All American jumper of Menchville, And Katrina Grier, All American jumper from West Charlotte. These are but a few who have made the Queen City Relays one of the top relay meets in the South.
