

Country Day Takes State Girls' Track

Country Day's girls' track team compiled 108 points in winning the N.C. Independent Schools Athletic Association track meet at Country Day Saturday. The Buccaneers easily outdistanced second-place Ben Lippen which had 73.

Charlotte Latin, the defending state champion, finished seventh with 31 points.

Country Day was led by Kim Kelly who won the 100-meter low hurdles and 200-meter dash and Tracey Ladd, who finished second in the 100-meter low hurdles and long jump.

Country Day's 400-meter relay and 1,600-meter relay teams finished first to add to the Buccaneer total.

Greensboro Day finished third with 68, Forsyth Country Day (60) fourth and Asheville School (48). Rounding out the field were Durham Academy (40), Latin (31), Ravenscroft (6) and Charlotte Christian (0).

• Durham Academy's boys took the NCISAA state title Saturday at Country Day, beating second-place Greensboro Day 144-82. Country Day finished third with 79 points.

Durham Academy rolled up its points by winning four events and taking two or three places in the top three in five events.

The Buccaneers were led by Scott Smith's first and Scott Edwards's third in the pole vault. Edwards also won the 200-meter hurdles. Providence Day's Frank Jetton won the 1,600-meter run.

Forsyth Country Day finished fourth in the team standings with 40 points, followed by Asheville School (35), Ben Lippen (29), Gaston Day (23), Providence Day (21), Christ School (19), Northside (14), Latin (11), Charlotte Christian (0) and Ravenscroft (0).
