Mount Tabor Girls Take Title: West Forsyth's Smith Is Winner

Julie Smith of West Forsyth, who is in her first season of high-school cross country, and Robert Easter of Charlotte Garinger, who is in his last, won varsity titles in the Wake Forest High School Invitational cross-country meet yesterday.

Smith ran the 5,000-meter course in 21:07 to beat Tiffany Bennett of Chapel Hill, who ran a 21:42. Lauren Escott of Mount Tabor was third in 22:06.

Easter took the lead at the twomile mark to win ths boys event in 16:40, with Andrew Pearson of North Forsyth second in 16:50. David Mabe of North was third in 17:03.

Mount Tabor won the girls' team trophy with 41 points. Chapel Hill was second with 63. West Forsyth was third with 73.

Chapel Hill won the boys' team trophy with 72 points. Mount Tabor was second with 90 and North Forsyth was third with 106.

Smith and Bennett probably will be seeing a lot of each other in the next four years. Both girls are freshmen. Smith said that her strategy was to stay up with the pack for the first mile and then try to break away, which is just what she did. She took the lead in the second mile and held it the rest of the way.

"I don't look around to see who

is running with me," she said. "It might psych me out."

Bennett said she staved close with Smith for the first mile and a half. "Then she just took off," Bennett said. "I just tried to keep her in sight."

Easter stayed back in the early going as part of his race plan. He started making his move at about a mile and a half. Coming toward the finish he had a solid lead and didn't. push himself. These early races, he said, are preparation for the big meets ahead. Easter, who is a senior, has his eye on winning the national cross-country title.

Pearson was ahead in the early going of the boys' race. He said he wanted to go out fast and he did.

"I tried to hold on," Pearson said, "but he took the lead in the last mile."

Lauren Escott (third). Scottie Pate (seventh), Britt Armentrout (ninth), Kristy Sipek (10th) and Marla Bost (12th) led the Mount Tabor win.

Todd Mesibow (sixth), Pearson Don-Clark (eighth), Eric Feiss (17th), Eric Sanks (20th) and Chris Thomas (21st) led Chapel Hill to the boys' win.
