American teenagers raked in 48 medals at the Pan-American Juniors, the men winning 10 titles and the women garnering 14.

North Carolinian Johnny Dutch took both hurdles (13.46/50.82) as the lone U.S. double

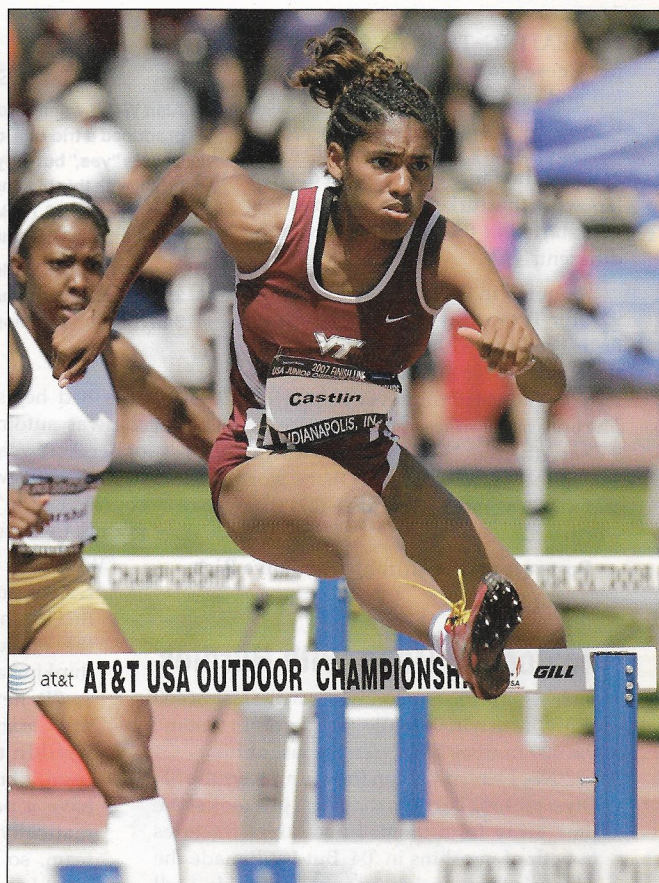

Robin Reynolds starred in the Youth Girls by taking the 200 (24.34), 400 (53.10) and 800 (2:15.78) and running 2nd in the 100 (11.99) by 0.01. The 53.10 broke Brandi Cross's age-14 record of 53.40.

Brittany Borman won three Young throws (45-1 SP, 137-7 DT, 136-4 JT).
